As usual we have invited officers from the 111th **Precinct** to give their regular police report. Do please remember our 50/50 raffle and food drive, (non-perishables please).


Hopefully by now you have noticed the Bayside Hills Beacon has a state-of-the-art updated


#### HEALTH CORNER STROKE PREVENTION

One of the benefits of Bayside Hills Civic Association (BHCA) membership is being able to apply for the student scholarship award. Annually, two middle school and two high school students of current BHCA member households are eligible for a \$50 scholarship award. The awards are presented to students who have demonstrated leadership qualities and concern for civic responsibility and good citizenship. Disciplines include environmental sustainability, volunteerism, advocacy for clean air and safe sustainable transportation, public health, education and other livability concerns. Students were asked to provide an essay application (1-2 pages) detailing their qualifications and were encouraged to include letters attesting to their achievements. The application deadline was May 15.

This year, one student, **Marina Tsimisiris**, an 8th grade graduate from St. Nicholas William Spyropoulos School in Flushing, will be awarded a scholarship at our June 27th general meeting. Marina's family have lived in Bayside Hills (and have been enduring members of the BHCA) since 2000. Marina was also born and raised in Bayside Hills. Marina's essay described her passion and dedication to environmental sustainability lifestyles. She will be attending Archbishop Molloy High School, located in Briarwood, Queens, in September. She loves math, biology, and technology. Congratulations Marina! 


#### **BHCA HELP CORNER!**
