HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS!

With Halloween just around the corner, here are some safety tips!

- Choose costumes that are bright and reflective. Make sure that shoes fit well and that costumes are short enough to prevent tripping, entanglement or contact with flame.
- Consider adding reflective tape or striping to costumes and trickor-treat bags for greater visibility.
- When shopping for costumes,

wigs and accessories look for and purchase those with a label clearly indicating they are flame resistant.

- A parent or responsible adult should always accompany young children on their neighborhood rounds.
- Remain on well-lit streets and always use the sidewalk.
- Never cross between parked cars.
- Consider purchasing non-food treats for those who visit your



home, such as coloring books or pens and pencils.

• Wait until children are home to sort and check treats. An adult should closely examine all treats and throw away any spoiled, unwrapped or suspicious items.

be in attendance with their regular report, plus our famous 50/50 raffle, clothing drive, and our wonderful refreshments.


A few words vis-à-vis our best attended Bayside Hills Civic Association 9/11 Memorial Observance. This year we


REMEMBERING 9/11, 16 YEARS LATER



BAYSIDE HILLS WATER MAIN CONSTRUCTION UPDATE!

The NYC Department of Design and Construction (DDC) is managing the project for the NYC Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). The main goal is to replace an existing 30-36 inch water main with a new 48" water main on Springfield from Horace Harding to 56th Avenue, on Luke Place from 218th St to 216th St, and 216th St from Luke Pl to 39th Avenue. The job is also replacing two existing 12-inch water mains on Springfield from Horace Harding to 56th Avenue with new ones of the same size. Also replaced were three catch basins that were blocking the placement of the new 48-inch water main. Upon completion of water main installation all streets will be resurfaced curb-to-curb. This project is expected to be completed by summer 2018.


