If you notice that our appearance has changed significantly from our previous issues, that's because every once in awhile the Bayside Hills Civic Association comes up with something wonderful. This time it materialized in the form of an extremely talented graphic designer, Yvonne Wong-Fein, who has volunteered to join the staff of our Bayside Hills Beacon publication as Creative Director. The BHCA Board of Directors is absolutely delighted to have Yvonne's exceptional abilities to enhance our newsletter.

Now it is time to really, I mean REALLY, focus on the future of the Bayside Hills malls, decaying cupolas, guideposts, planters, and other iconic structures that identify our neighborhood. On Friday, September 15th, members of our BHCA Beautification Committee had their first meeting in the office of Queens Borough President Melinda Katz to discuss plans for the future of our malls, iconic structures and a \$500,000 allocation from the Office of the Borough President. Discussions included replacement of crumbling curbs, identifying and replacing dead or dying trees, possible introduction of bioswales, (simple landscaping features used to slow, collect, infiltrate, and filter storm water), power raking, seeding, pedestrian ramps, and other possibilities. Besides our BHCA Beautification Committee members there was a most impressive panel; in attendance was our City Council Member Barry Grodenchik who, along with Queens Budget Director Richard Lee, hosted our discussion. In addition there were Councilman Grodenchik's Chief of Staff Ari Gershman; Ilan Kutok, Director of Green Infrastructure, NYC Dept. of Parks and Recreation; Community Board 11's Department of Parks' liaison Joseph Block; the Administrative Associate at NYC Department of Transportation, Richard Gippetti; and the Director of Constituent Services, from Queens Borough President Melinda Katz's Office, Ann Marie Boranian. Our Beautification Committee members who were present, and I, truly feel progress was made. Prior to our next meeting in December, estimates for repairs to our structures will be submitted and we'll continue to meet regularly until hopefully we can see shovels in the ground.

While on the subject of our malls, how about some kudos for our BHCA Beautification Committee and their helpers for the work they have been doing for quite some time now? There's Chair Ronald Keil (Garden World-Keil Bros), who planted flowers all over town including our 9/11 Memorial Garden; clock, flagpole area and elsewhere; Eileen Miller, BHCA Board member and our CB 11 representative, painter of our Bell Boulevard sign; Bayside Hills residents such as Jo-Ann Skutch with our neighborhood all-star gardeners including BHCA Board members Jack Niedermyer, and Sebastian D'Agostino; Jay Koellner, who is responsible for our beautiful clock; and Rita and Rich Kashdan, who are in charge of hanging the signs announcing our BHCA events. BTW: The Kashdans immediately prior to our BHCA 9/11 Observance, spent considerable hours in the heat painting and beautifying the planter and gate house near our spectacular Bayside Hills Memorial Garden. Board of Director's election, we will have representatives from QED 1002, vis-à-vis what is to be a \$19.7 million upgrade to the water delivery and sewer systems in the Bayside Hills neighborhood of Queens. Last summer work began to install nearly 3 miles of new distribution water mains. The new ductile iron mains are to replace the unlined cast iron mains that currently serve the neighborhood and were installed in the 1930s. The project is also to include the installation of 1.3 miles of new steel trunk water mains, which serve as a conduit between the large water tunnels and the local distribution mains. The new water mains are to help accommodate the added demand from the growing population of Northeast Queens and should ensure adequate water pressure for firefighters and a reliable supply of high quality drinking water for the area. The project is being funded by DEP and managed by the Department of Design and Construction. It was expected to be completed during the summer of 2016. Apparently, for some reason, there have been difficulties in regards to this construction project, too numerous to mention here. Therefore with the assistance of Community Board 11, this construction project will be the featured topic the evening of November 29th.

Finally, on Sunday, December 18th at 5:00 PM, we will be having our BHCA Holiday Lighting Festival; more on that in our November Bayside Hills Beacon. For now, we hope to see everybody at our "Candidate's Night" General Meeting on the evening of October 25th at 8:00.
