Dermody Triangle Restoration Update

Last month, board members of the Bayside Hills Civic Association met with city and state officials, including Borough Parks Commissioner Dottie Lewandowski, and State Senator Tony Avella, to discuss the Dermody Triangle repair and restoration. Through the office of Senator Avella, \$275,000 was allocated for the restoration and repair of Dermody Triangle. As of yet, there is no time frame for the project, but the city hopes to have it completed this year.

Here is a list of the structural changes planned for the site:

• All walkways will be replaced with paving blocks.

- Entry to the park will become handicap accessible.
- Eight benches, at least two concrete tables and a few concrete garbage pails will be added.
- New trees will be planted for shade.
- All streetlights will be checked and either repaired or replaced based on need.


BHCA HELP CORNER!!
